

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites and applications that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites and applications work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners. The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

Cookie	Name	Purpose
Universal Analytics (Google)	_ga _gali _gat _gid	These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our website. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the website. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the website and blog, where visitors have come to the website from and the pages they visited. Read Google's overview of privacy and safeguarding data
Application firewall cookie	__zjc*	This cookie is set by a third-party web application firewall from Dyn to help maintain the security and performance of our website. Some traffic may receive a challenge to check if it is genuine and if it is, a cookie is set so the user isn't challenged again.
